REQUEST FOR TRADING HALT

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.1, Blaze Minerals Limited (ACN 074 728 019) (**Company**) requests an immediate trading halt be granted by ASX in respect of its ordinary shares from the commencement of trading today, Monday, 22 May 2023.

The trading halt is requested to facilitate an orderly market in the Company's securities pending an announcement in relation to the outcome of a placement to sophisticated and professional investors (**Announcement**).
